General Information

In addition to any policies or guidelines provided in the official Bylaws of the Ocean Beach Planning Board, the following information is provided to facilitate the regular election process of the planning group for the 2018-2020 term of service. Any additional policy or guidelines not specifically addressed here will be in accordance with Council Policy 600-24, the City of San Diego's guidelines for Community Planning Group Elections or Roberts Rules of Order.

- **Election Day:** **Wednesday, March 7, 2018. Polling open 4–7pm.** All mail-in ballots must be postmarked by this date.
- **Polling Location:** Ocean Beach Recreation Center, 4726 Santa Monica Avenue, San Diego CA 92107

Instructions for Voting

Step 1: Determine Eligibility. All persons who meet the eligibility criteria below are allowed to vote in the elections. It is not necessary to be a registered voter with the state or county government.

To be eligible, voters must demonstrate that they are 18 years of age and meet one of the following conditions within the Ocean Beach Community Plan Area for more than 30 days:

- **A resident:** Residing in and maintaining a physical address
- **A property owner:** Owning property
- **A business licensee/owner:** Owning/operating a business with a physical address/location

(Proof of the above may be established with a copy of a driver's license [or other government ID] in addition to a copy of a utility bill, business license, or tax bill that demonstrates the qualifying address of the voter.)

Step 2: Register to Vote. Complete the Voter Registration Form on the next page, then **register in person** by one of the following methods:

- On Election Day when voting (**Wednesday, March 7, 2018**)
- At an OBPB meeting (1st Wednesday of each month, 6pm)
- By appointment with a member of the Election Committee. The deadline to register by appointment is **Friday March 2nd @ 5pm**. Appointments must be arranged ahead of time by contacting elections@oceanbeachplanning.org

Step 3: Vote in Person or via Mail-in Ballot

- In-person voting will take place on **Wednesday, March 7, 2018 4-7pm** at the Ocean Beach Recreation Center, 4726 Santa Monica Avenue, San Diego CA 92107.
- Voting by mail is also permitted. Registered voters can pick up a mail-in ballot at the time of registration, or they may request that a ballot be mailed to them (requests must be made no later than February 22). Mail-in ballots must be postmarked by March, 2nd 2018.
- **Voters may only vote for candidates representing their district.**
