7/23/19 Meeting Minutes

- Tracy has minor grammar edits – Jenna will fix them.

Non-Agenda Public Comment

- Nicole serves on District 5 Mobility Board – working on a budget letter
- Nicole recommends finding an OB Main Street Association representative. Would have to get another OB Planning Board member on the Subcommittee first. It would be helpful to discuss creating a Parking District.
- Rick suggested a discussion about repaving on Bacon – bring this up with City Councilwoman Campbell's office.
- Andrea is still discussing with the city about bollards at the pier to prevent vehicles from driving on it.

Action Item #1: Way-finding Signage for Biking and Micro-mobility

- Discussed Nicole's recommendations for an OB Bike Path.
- Next steps: Type up recommendations and develop a map for presentation to the OB Planning Board, likely in February.
- **Motion:** Make a request to the OB Planning Board for wayfinding signage to the OB Planning Board.
 - **Vote:** Passed unanimously.

Action Item #2: Traffic Calming Presentation with OBMA regarding Newport Ave. Diverters

- Table this item until we find out more about the resurfacing plans for Bacon.

Action Item #3: Robb Field and Dog Beach Bike Path Repaving

- Mike Rodriguez from Mission Bay Improvement Fund – provided information that funds cannot be used for maintenance. We would need to make a pitch for CIP funding to the Mission Bay Park Committee meeting. The Transportation and Stormwater Division makes maintenance upgrades, so we could try making requests through the Get it Done app.
- Andrea will check records if this was a previous CIP request from OB Planning Board. Tracy will ask Council Member Campbell’s office for more information. Follow up on this on our meeting in January.

Action Item #4: School Safety and Traffic Calming Proposals for OB Elementary

- Accident: 18-year old was riding a bike on Sunset Cliffs and got hit by a car at Newport in front of kids.
- Need more signage and safety controls, particularly on Santa Monica and Newport. Changes approved for Sunset Cliffs and Newport, but as far as we know, changes are not planned for Santa Monica and Newport. Letter should include request for LPI with the recommendation for no right turn on a red light for all times. Ideally, would also like a crossing guard program too, but OB Elementary cannot use 5th and 6th graders like other schools, so this would be a cost to the city. PTA or PLA could fundraise for a cost-share for city staff.
- **Motion:** Traffic Subcommittee recommends support the letter to Council Member Campbell, the San Diego School Board representative, and Department of Transportation and Storm Water regarding OB Elementary School Traffic mitigation. Passed unanimously.
 - **Vote:** Passed unanimously.

Information Item #1: Review 2nd Phase Plans for West Point Loma Blvd. Road Diet and Bike Lane Implementation

- Road diet will start December 2019 and goes through February 2020, depending on the weather.
