- 13% tree canopy cover
- 11 Years as a Tree City USA

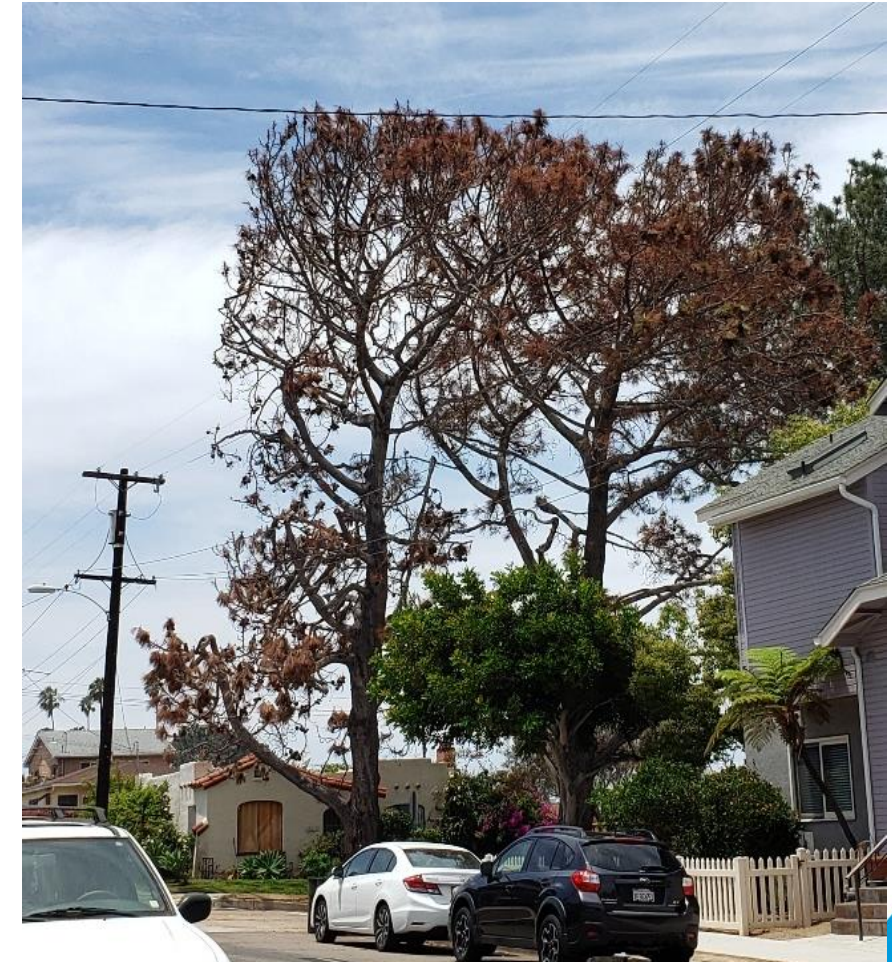

Torrey Pines on Saratoga and Long Branch

- Both trees dedicated as Landmark/Historic trees in 2016
- Planted in 1920s?
- 4611 Saratoga treated with insecticide on July 9th 2020 – Tree found dead this January, removal this month.

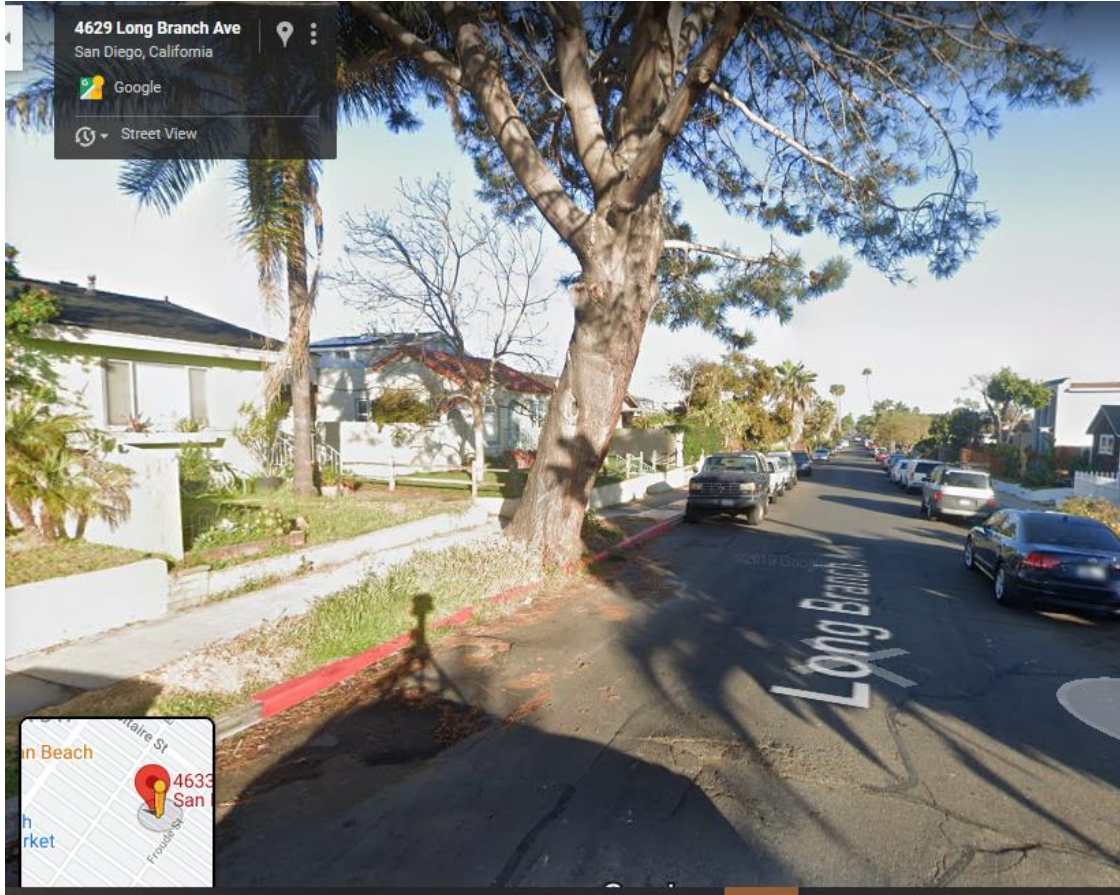

Timeline of Events

- City of San Diego monitors about every 6 months
- On 4.9.2021 – TSW arborist evaluated tree, found dieback and large crack in limb
- On 4.9.2021 a large 14-inch + limb was removed from the tree as an emergency work order
- Tree was treated on 4.15.21 for turpentine beetle
- We are monitoring this tree every week

Torrey Pine on Long Branch

Short and Long Term

- Removing large branches and another tree prune in June
- Continue to monitor
- Condition has been the same for the last month
- Possible decline in tree within the next year
