### Information Item #1: Organic Waste Recycling

Megan Presenting.

- Miramar Landfill receives 900,000 tons of trash every year.
- Created a recycle ordinance. Amended it to include organic waste.
- This includes food waste, yard waste, untreated wood, food-soiled paper products.
- 50% by 2020, 75% by 2025.
- Why do we have to do this:
  - On going droughts, hotter temperatures, reduces greenhouse gas and methane emissions.
- Three facilities in San Diego
- What goes into containers:
  - Food scraps, bad food, unfinished food
  - Coffee filters, napkins, paper
  - Indoor plant and outdoor trimmings
- Not acceptable:
  - Plastic, food oils/grease, foodware, tea bags, recyclables, cleaning supplies, etc.
  - Pet waste, human waste
- Fees will occur for nonacceptable waste.
- 39% of landfill is organic waste.
- Tips for storing:
  - Put in freezer, drain out liquids with napkins.
- Senate bill 1383
- Will receive green cart and kitchen pail.
